

Step-by-Step Instructions for Activating Two-factor Authentication

Yahoo! Mail [Turn two-step verification on \(or off\)](#)

Note: if you use Yahoo! Mail through AT&T, 2-factor authentication is not available.

1. Sign in and go to your Account security page.
2. Next to Two-step verification, click the toggle button to enable
3. Enter your mobile number.
4. Click Send SMS to receive a text message with a code or Call me to receive a phone call.
5. Enter the verification code | click Verify.

GMAIL Visit [Google's 2-step verification page](#) and click on get started. Follow the prompts to enter your cell phone number and turn on 2-step verification. (Took less than 2 minutes).

Outlook [How to set up two-step verification with a phone number](#)

1. [Follow this link to access your Security settings](#) on your Microsoft Account and sign in with your credentials. (Alternatively, you can also sign in to your [Outlook.com](#) account, click your name in the top-right corner, and click **Account settings**.)
2. Click the **Set up two-step verification** link.
3. Click **Next**.
4. Select the **A phone number** option from the drop-down list and enter your phone information.
5. Choose whether you like to get the security code via text or call and click **Next**. Enter the code you have received on phone and click **Next**.
6. Click **Next** again.
7. Click **Finish** to complete.
